Regarding why jazz video performances cannot be offered:

For all video recordings, we must get mechanical licenses for the audio portion and then synchronization licenses for the video portion.

Obtaining and paying for mechanical licenses is controlled by law and are compulsory, meaning that the copyright holder **MUST** allow us to purchase the licenses. But the process of obtaining synchronization licenses is much more difficult, often costly, and in many cases impossible.

Many of the arrangements that jazz bands use are “arrangements without permission” and in these cases licenses is impossible.

Also, the copyright to many of the jazz pieces in legitimate arrangements are held by major companies that do not want to sell small amounts of licenses, or they may charge an exorbitant amount. All of these factors combine to make video recordings of jazz bands and jazz choirs not feasible.

We are sorry about that, but we cannot control the situation. We would very much like to make jazz videos available, but the current state of copyright laws make that impossible. However, audio recordings of jazz performances will be available.
